

FLOOD SAFETY

Boulder is rated #1 flash flood risk community in Colorado.

Floods don't always behave the same way and communities may not have the same amount of time to prepare as in previous floods.

▷ BUILD RESPONSIBLY

Before beginning any flood-related projects for your property, **assess** whether a City of Boulder permit is needed. Visit 1739 Broadway or call 303-441-1880 for detailed information.

▷ KEEP LOCAL WATERWAYS CLEAN

Storm drains lead to creeks! **Protect** our waterways by clearing debris and keeping pollutants out of storm drains.

▷ FOLLOW SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Move to higher ground and do not drive or wade through floodwaters.

▷ PROTECT YOUR PROPERTY

Keep electrical components, furniture, valuables, and important documents in a **secure** place or above your home's projected flood elevation.

▷ INSURE YOUR HOME

Property owners should **ensure** the safety of their home by purchasing flood insurance. The city's participation in the Community Rate System (CRS), currently provides customers with up to 25 percent off of flood insurance and you can buy flood insurance whether you're in a floodplain or not.

▷ KNOW YOUR FLOODPLAIN

Check to see if your property is in the floodway, high hazard zone, wetland area, or has been impacted by historic events. View maps and elevation certificates online at www.BoulderFloodInfo.net, stop by 1739 Broadway or call 303-441-1880 for detailed Flood Insurance Rate Map (FIRM) information.
