The City of Boulder's snow crews are ready to respond 24 hours a day from mid-September to the end of April to snowy and icy conditions. The snow crews work hard to keep primary and secondary streets, on-street bike lanes, bike and multi-use paths open using materials and equipment that help reduce the dangers inherent in winter travelling.

Sidewalk Snow Removal

All owners or residents of private property must have the snow on their sidewalks cleared within 24 hours after it stops snowing. Shoveling sidewalks helps prevent accidents and increases accessibility for pedestrians. Snowfall reports at: www.nws.noaa.gov/data/obhistory/KBDU.html.
