

DID YOU KNOW?

Trees only need a small amount of winter watering.

City of Boulder Urban Parks suggests a rate of 10-14 gallons per diameter inch of the tree per month. For example, if your tree has a 10-inch diameter, it only needs 100-140 gallons once per month.

WASTEWATER CHARGES EXPLAINED

Wastewater charges are based on the water use billed on the December through March utility bills. The city averages the use shown on these bills to estimate the amount of water used inside your home and entering the sanitary sewer system. During the summer months when outside water use increases, wastewater charges are capped at this inside use estimate. To reduce wastewater charges throughout the year, please conserve water during the winter months.
