

DOES YOUR TOILET WASTE WATER?

A leaking toilet can waste up to 500 gallons of water per day! Check for leaks and make repairs quickly to save water and money.

TIPS FOR FINDING TOILET LEAKS

- ▶ Add a few drops of blue food coloring into the toilet tank water, wait a minute and if you see blue coloring in the toilet bowl, you have leak.
- ▶ Water sits in a toilet tank until it's flushed, but if the water level in your toilet tank is too high, water will flow into an "overflow tube" and into the drain.
